Use this Family Conference Guide and allow God to direct you and other family members as you determine your financial commitment. Set aside a specific time free of normal distractions to discuss, read and pray according to the guidelines given below. God will reveal His will to every family that seeks Him.

Purpose: To pray, study, and communicate with one another to discover God's will concerning your commitment to **IMMEASURABLY MORE**.

Preparation:

- Participate in daily devotions offered in the IMMEASURABLY MORE Prayer Guide so God has the opportunity to prepare every family member. (guides can be downloaded from https://relentlesschurch.cc/immeasurably-more/)
- Set a time for your family meeting. The meeting will probably take thirty minutes to an hour, depending on the age of your children.
- Instruct each family member to begin thinking of sacrifices that God wants that person, and the entire family, to make in order to make a great investment in God's work.
